- **We will make the hotel reservations. Please do not contact Country Inn & Suites.**

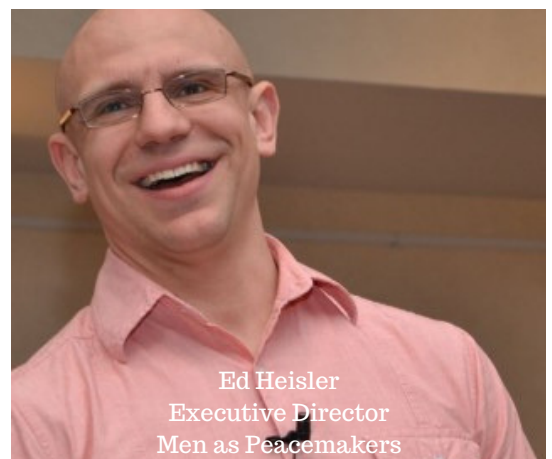
